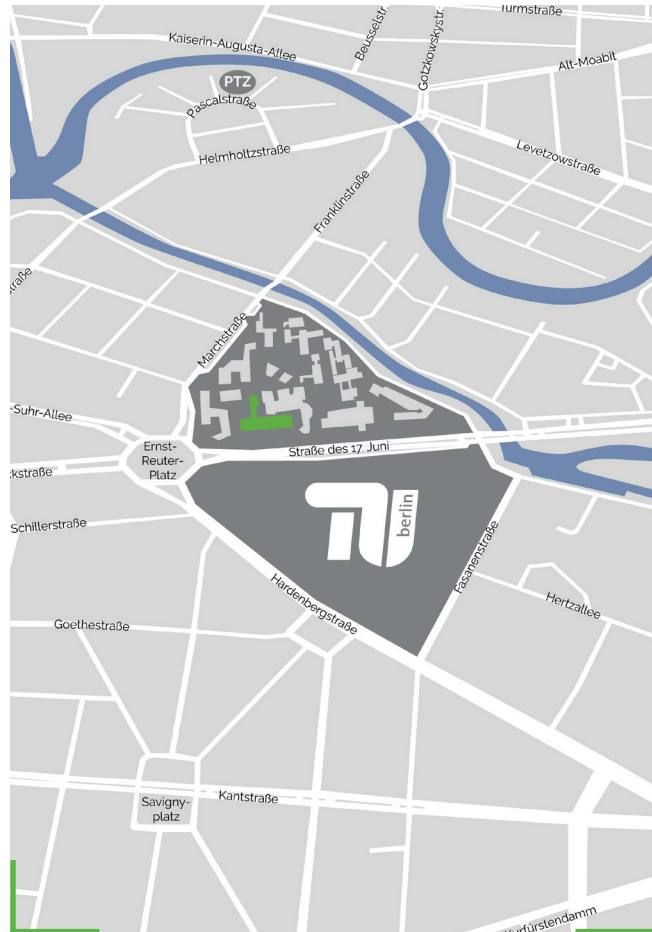

Target Audience

The event is aimed at decision-makers and experts in the field of virtual driving simulation. The event will be supplemented with the 2nd OpenSCENARIO User Meeting on June 29, 2016.

Objective

The 2nd Symposium Driving Simulation discusses the current state of driving simulation technology. The topical key points will focus on systems for driver assistance and for autonomous driving and also on user-centric development.
