### Research scope

Proposals must address issues on hematopoietic stem cell transplantation or cell therapy for hematological diseases. Various aspects can be covered, including but not limited to: diagnostic and therapeutic strategies, transplant immunology, stem cell transplantation complications, donor selection, or cell manufacturing.

### Description

The DKMS John Hansen Research Grant provides funding for each awardee up to a maximum of **€240,000, paid out over a 3-year period** (maximum €80,000 annually).

### Preconditions of researchers

- >>** Doctoral degree (PhD, MD, or equivalent achievements) in a field pertinent to the grant within the last 10 years from the grant call start date.
- >>** Applicants from all countries are invited to submit an application.
