Invitation to Kiel

The Max Rubner-Institut, location Kiel, invites you to participate in the 2nd Kiel Food Science Symposium and to submit contributions for oral presentations or posters. The symposium will be held from May 22-23, 2012, at the Max Rubner-Institut in Kiel. It will start at 1:00 pm on May 22, 2012, and ends at 1:00 pm on May 23, 2012. Official language of the symposium will be English.

A half-day national workshop with a strict focus on dairy science („Kieler Milchvormittag“) will precede the conference in the morning of May 22, 2012, at the same venue (9:00-12:00 am). It is possible to participate in this workshop (language: German) by separate registration (see separate announcement).

Scope of the Symposium

The Kiel Food Science Symposium takes place in a 2-year rhythm. The aim of this international symposium is:

- to offer a scientific platform for representatives from academia, industry, food authorities and policy,
- to stimulate the presentation of up-to-date research activities,
- to obtain information on new developments and
- to exchange views with colleagues from many countries on scientific progress and applications.

The symposium will address various aspects of scientific research on:

- Functional Food (first day)
- Food Safety (second day)

with a focus on dairy products and seafood.

Plenary Lectures

Internationally recognized experts will present plenary lectures:

- **Prof. H.G. Kristinsson**, Icelandic Food Research, Reykjavík, Iceland: Functional food from marine resources
- **Prof. R.J. FitzGerald**, University of Limerick, Limerick, Ireland: Bioactive peptides from food proteins
- **PD Dr. L. Beutin**, Federal Institute for Risk Assessment, Berlin, Germany: EHEC in food - current state of knowledge
- **Prof. A. Lopata**, James Cook University, Townsville, Queensland, Australia: Health risk of parasites in fish



How to Get to the Symposium

Kiel is the capital city of the most northern federal state in Germany (Schleswig-Holstein) located at the beautiful Kiel Fjord of the Baltic Sea. With its maritime flair, Kiel is also well-known as the world capital of sailing („Kiel week“). Kiel can be reached conveniently by all kinds of public transport facilities:

- by airplane to Hamburg airport or to Lübeck airport. An hourly-served shuttlebus („Kielius“) is connecting Hamburg airport with Kiel city. Hourly served train connections are also linking Kiel with Hamburg and Lübeck.
- by ferry from Sweden, Norway, Lithuania and Russia
- by car via A 215 motorway which ends close to the city centre.

Accommodation

The Max Rubner-Institut - Location Kiel is in the city centre in walking distance to the harbour and to the central station. A number of hotels of various categories are in close vicinity of the Symposium venue.
