Exploring Difference: Transnational Education – Models, Drivers and Challenges

The series **INTERNATIONAL DIALOGUE ON EDUCATION BERLIN** is a joint initiative of the British Council, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), the Australian Group of Eight, the Canadian Bureau for International Education/Embassy of Canada in Germany and Freie Universität Berlin. Through the contributions of international participants the series aims to enrich the debate on science, research and higher education policy in Germany, to place German perspectives in a global context and to learn from positive examples from other countries.

The ninth conference in the ID-E Berlin series will focus on the Anglo-American and French models of Transnational Education (TNE) and examine the drivers, trends and challenges of cross-border education projects. Drawing on examples from their own education systems and at their own institutions, a detailed understanding of the different systems and new developments of TNE will be elicited from experts from Australia, the United Kingdom, France, Canada and the United States of America. The event will be followed by a conference focusing on the "German Model" of TNE organised by DAAD, supported by the Stifterverband für die Deutsche Wissenschaft.
