Since 2006 the Ernst Haage Prize awards young scientists for outstanding achievements in the field of chemical science and promotes particularly young academics.


The Ernst Haage-Foundation awards the prize which is endowed with € 7,500.

Nominees must be scientists who hold a doctorate from a German research institution/university. They should have their primary residence in Germany, be no more than 40 years old and not have a permanent employment contract.

Nominations may be submitted to the Foundation's Board of Trustees by E-Mail (ernsthaagepreis@cec.mpg.de) by August 3rd 2019 and should include the following documents:

- Two pages of laudation
- Curriculum vitae in table form
- Complete publication list
- Up to three reprints of works of the nominated person.
