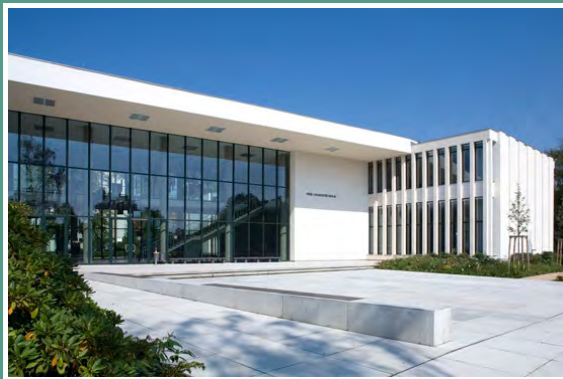

IGSC 2013 VENUE HENRY FORD BUILDING

The IGSC 2013 will be held at Henry Ford Building in the picturesque south-western part of Berlin. The central event venue of Freie Universität Berlin is protected as a historic monument and sparkles as a jewel of architecture that epitomizes freedom, openness and transparency. The building complex with its state-of-the-art media technology, spacious meeting rooms and light-flooded exhibition space is regularly used as a conference center for international congresses and award ceremonies.



OPENING CEREMONY & ICEBREAKER RECEPTION (25 APR 2013)

After the IGSC 2013 Opening Ceremony with welcoming speeches by representatives of SGS, Geo.X and Freie Universität Berlin, music performances and a special motivational keynote, up to 1,200 students, professionals and members of the geoscience community of the Berlin-Brandenburg Metropolitan Region kick off the IGSC 2013 with food and drinks at the icebreaker reception in the exhibition lobby of Henry Ford Building.



CONFERENCE EVENING (26 APR 2013)

Berlin's museum of natural history will serve as an exclusive location for a truly unforgettable IGSC 2013 Conference Evening. Fossil celebrities will await up to 400 delegates with food and drinks in a unique atmosphere in the nightly illuminated museum building. Attendees can partake in guided tours through those parts of the museum which are normally not open to the public. Since its establishment in 1810, the collections of the Museum für Naturkunde have become so extensive that today less than one in 5,000 of the more than 30 million specimens is exhibited.
