**Maurice Stephan Michel** is Professor of Urology and Head of the Department of Urology of the University of Mannheim. His scientific interests are related to the improvement and development of surgical technology for genitourinary malignancies.

**Jürgen Debus** is Professor of Radiooncology and Head of the Department of Radiooncology and Radiation Therapy of the University of Heidelberg. The Department of Radiation Oncology and Radiation Therapy is among the world’s most advanced centers for radiation therapy offering because the entire spectrum of radio-oncological diagnosis and therapy. His main focus is the improvement of radiation technologies with the ultimate goal to target more precisely and effectively the tumor while reducing the toxicity of the therapy. In this context, the Heidelberg Ion

Beam Therapy Center HIT was added to the technological repertoire of the Department. **Jürgen Weitz** is Professor of Surgery and Vice Chairman of the Department of General-, Visceral- and Transplantation Surgery. He is head of the division of Surgical Oncology, the scientific working group of Molecular Oncology and the Clinical Research Group: Colorectal Cancer: From primary tumor progression towards metastasis (KFO 227). His basic interest relates to surgical advances for the treatment of complex and advanced tumors.

**Sascha Pahernik** is Associate Professor and Vice Chairman of the Department of Urology of the University of Heidelberg. His main focus of research is urooncology, in particular minimal invasive options for the treatment of renal cell cancer and prostate cancer.
